




#### Chamber Series -Bachtoberfest 2022

### Looking back at last year: What did we spend our time doing in 2021-2022 ?

- Volunteering: LJA and sponsors worked 15 concerts and completed ~ over 400 service hours in support of BRSO and BRSL activities; Members also volunteered untold hours to support our traditional fund raisers: Mad Hatters and Bal de la Symphonie.
- Honoring: 19 Seniors were honored at the December 21 Bal de la Symphonie and at the Spring "Senior Send-off" luncheon on May 7.
- Gaining Recognition: BRSL's Mad Hatters fund raiser was recognized by the League of American Orchestras with a "Spotlight Award" for innovation and creativity! Continuing the trend, the 2022 Mad Hatters "Artistas & Fashionistas" brought in more \$50,000 in revenue this year.
- Winning Grants: the Baton Rouge Junior League recently awarded BRSL's "Symphony on the Geaux" camp project with a \$1310 Community Assistance Fund grant to support the supplies needed for this 3-day camp that is held in conjunction with the Boys and Girls Club in June.
- **Organizing**: BRSL members participated and helped organize the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala

- **Treating the Musicians:** Cookies and sweet treats were delivered to the musicians to sweeten their last practice prior to the final concert of the successful 2021-22 season
- *Fine Dining:* Many thanks to Stroubes for sponsoring the pre-concert dinners for the Opening and Closing Nights this year! Not only are the meals delicious, Stroubes also donates profits as a fundraiser.

Symphony on the Geaux (formerly known as Culture Camp), is a 3-day mini camp held in conjunction with Boys Club/Girls Club of Baton Rouge. Each summer, the Baton Rouge Symphony League partners with Boys Club & Girls Club to coordinate and provide volunteers for a 3 day "camp within a camp". Members of LJA (Les Jeunes Amies), volunteer before and during the camp with hands-on support of the event.

This project directly supports the BR Symphony League's mission of "fostering music appreciation among children" by providing a fun, hands on set of camp activities introducing symphony, dance, and music related arts & crafts during the camp session. Some of the activities include:

- Meet the conductor where they learn about instruments and can touch and play on real instruments
- Create DIY Drum Kit / Guitar / Maracas
- Music history activity pages
- Learning a Hip-Hop dance routine
- Receive a craft book with a set of supplies that can be used for school

This in person camp has positive reviews from both the participants and the volunteers! For 2022, the camp was held June 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> and reached 50+ campers in 3rd-4th grade
