What is BRSL most well-known for?

- **Mad Hatters** – one of the oldest and beloved spring events in Baton Rouge, Mad Hatters is a primary fundraiser for BRSL. While themes for the luncheon change each year, the “hat-raising” fun is consistent, along with a fabulous style / fashion focused event with an amazing silent auction (Hat wearing is optional, but part of the fun, with prizes awarded in several categories).
- **Les Jeunes Aimes de la Symphonie** – Young Friends of the Symphony, or LJA – a 4 year educational and volunteer program for girls grades 9 through 12. Through-out the program, they donate their time and efforts at BRSO concerts and events.
- **Bal de la Symphonie** - BRSL presents the LJA members in their senior year at an elegant white-tie ball, celebrating the LJA members on their 4 years of service to the BRSO and BRSL.
- **Symphony on the Geaux** - a summer camp held in conjunction with Boys Club/Girls Club of Baton Rouge that provides enrichment activities related to the Symphony.
- **Pre-Concert Dinners** – For several of the orchestral concerts, we will organize pre-concert dinners for the patron enjoyment at downtown restaurants
- **Attending BRSO concerts** – BRSL fundamentally supports the Symphony through attendance at concerts; the LJA members can be seen taking tickets or passing out programs, and attending the concerts.
- **General support** – Arms and legs for the Symphony; helping out with a variety of events when needed.
